Dear Parents/Guardians of BCCS K-1 Students,

I hope this update finds you well while preparing for the upcoming holiday break.

This week we have noted an uptick in illness among our students and staff. This includes confirmed cases of COVID in the building. As with all communicable diseases, parents report known cases of COVID with BCCS students to the office, even positive cases that occur over the break. There are multiple reasons for your communication with the school including close contact communications with members of the BCCS educational community, and schools are to report known cases of communicable diseases including COVID. Influenza A, RSV etc.. to the Kent County Health Department on a weekly basis. Also, we remind families that the school has COVID tests available for our students and their household members, as needed.
