Your Help, Please....

As of late we have experienced an inordinate amount of parents/guardians not following the school's attendance protocols and policies.

- 1. <u>Reporting Absences</u>: Parents are to report absences by calling or emailing the office stating the name, grade and reason for the absence. This is expected for every occurrence of an absence.
- 2. Extended Absence Requests: If parents need to remove a child from school for multiple days, the parent/guardian is to follow the same protocol of calling/emailing reporting the student's name, grade, dates and reasons of absences to the office. Internal communications with teachers will follow, as appropriate. Parents may also wish to communicate with the student's teacher(s) for their awareness and often to request school work, which is appropriate and appreciated, yet the report of all absences are to be initiated through the office.

Concerns in General with Attendance

Our school continues to have an inordinate number of students chronically absent and/or tardy. This creates disruptions in education for the absent student, and additional time and effort needed by teachers. Of course we do not want students attending when ill, yet we ask that parents/guardians make a priority to help create the conditions for successful on-time and regular school attendance of students. Your awareness and consideration is appreciated.

Please note that BCCS makes a concerted effort to recognize and celebrate student success. In a couple weeks students will be receiving mid-year report cards. Please join us in recognizing student's areas of success and or growth with each student and identifying and challenging areas of self improvement in the school setting.
