Parent Teacher Conferences: Spring conferences will be held in person on Thursday, March 2 from 12:30-8:00 pm. *Registration will begin today.*

- Registration *will open to all students' parents* after school on Friday (2/22) through Tuesday (2/28).
- All conferences are to be scheduled prior to 7:30 am on Wednesday, March 1.

Please Note: Mrs. Arringdale (K-12 PE), Mrs. Holstege (K-12 Music/Band) and Miss Pham(K-12 Art) will not have scheduled conferences;rather,conferences will be held on a *Drop-In* basis in the respective classrooms. Mrs. Arringdale will hold conferences in her office, located in the southeast corner of the gym.

<u>Student Test Scores</u>: The latest student test scores will be shared at Parent Teacher Conferences to include the 2022-23 Winter MAP Growth tests (Grades K-8).
