BCCS Enrollment 2024-25

While most current BCCS Families have submitted enrollment forms for the 2024-25 school year, some students have not turned in their forms to lock-in the place for next year. By school policy, for existing students to reserve your spot for next school year, re-enrollment forms must be submitted to the school by April 15. Any forms submitted after that time are subjected to the possibility of a lottery should the requests exceed the limit of 22 students per grade level.

State Testing Update

State testing ramps-up just after break. A Letter from the state Superintendents can be found here <u>LINK</u>, and most pressing/timely information for mid-high students is below.

State Standardized Testing Grades 8-12

Thursday, April 11th: All 11th grade students will take the ACT WorkKeys Test

Tuesday April 16: All 8th graders will be taking the PSAT

Wednesday, April 17: All 9th - 11th graders will be taking the SAT/PSAT on Wednesday, April 17.

- 9th and 10th grade students will take the PSAT in individual classrooms.
- 11th grade students will take the SAT in the Art Room.
 - **** 12th grade students have no school at BCCS on April 17, but are expected to attend KCTC
 - **** 11th grade students will be dismissed from school late morning (around 11:30 AM) for the remainder of the day after the test is completed.

Important Notes:

Testing begins at 8:00 AM, so please have students at school by 7:45 AM. Each student needs to bring a fully charged Chromebook, chromebook charger, chromebook case and an approved calculator for this test.
