Dear Parents,

Good Afternoon, welcome back and hoping all enjoyed spring break. This letter is being sent to inform parents that as of noon today, the school's internet was restored after an unexpected power outage shortly after midnight last night. As a result, we were unable to use the school phones and computers during the outage period. We apologize for any inconvenience in communications to and from the school during that time.

Below are also a couple timely informational items to share.

Solar Eclipse

The solar eclipse is to occur in our area beginning at 1:55 through 4:55 PM. Though we are not directly in the path of a total eclipse, the peak/maximum time is 3:11 pm.

In an effort to keep all students safe while experiencing this unique phenomena, the school purchased and distributed eclipse glasses to all BCCS K-12 students. Students are also given instruction in how to use the glasses when looking at the eclipse.

Please note:

- At no time should people in our area look at the eclipse without using the protective glasses
- We are not in the path of the total eclipse, therefore at no time is it safe to look at the sun without properly using the protective glasses.

How to Use Eclipse Glasses

- Hold the eclipse glasses with two hands
- Stand with the front of your body toward the Sun, but look down
- Still looking down, put the eclipse glasses onto your face
- When they are securely fastened, raise your head and look up at the Sun
- Do not walk around with them on your face, because you can't see anything through the protective glasses.

Middle Cross Country Practice

For those students attending the Middle School Cross Country Practice, Mrs. Arrindale will take the students outside for a portion of the practice to safely view the eclipse using the eclipse glasses. The remainder of the practice will be held inside for the safety of the students.

State Testing Update

State Standardized Testing Grades 8-12

<u>Thursday, April 11th</u>: All 11th grade student will take the ACT WorkKeys Test <u>Tuesday. April 16:</u> All 8th graders will be taking the PSAT

Wednesday, April 17: All 9th - 11th graders will be taking the SAT/PSAT on Wednesday, April 17.

- 9th and 10th grade students will take the PSAT in individual classrooms
- 11th grade will take the SAT in the Art Room

Important Notice:

- <u>12th grade students have no school at BCCS on April 17, but are expected to attend</u>
 <u>KCTC</u>
- <u>11th grade students will be dismissed from school late morning (around 11:30 AM) for the remainder of the day after the test is completed.</u>

Testing begins at 8:00 AM, so please have students at school by 7:45 AM. Each student needs to bring a fully charged Chromebook, chromebook charger, chromebook case and an approved calculator for this test.
