PSAT/SAT Standardized Testing Update

All 8th graders will be taking the PSAT test on Tuesday, April 16 All 9th - 11th graders will be taking the SAT/PSAT on Wednesday, April 17.

- 9th and 10th grade students will take the PSAT in individual classrooms.
- 11th grade will be in the Art Room taking the SAT.

• <u>12th grade students have no school at BCCS on April 17</u>, but are expected to attend KCTC. IMPT: Testing begins at 8:00 AM, so please have students at school by 7:45 AM. Each student needs to bring a <u>fully charged Chromebook</u> and an approved calculator for this test. Please also bring your Chromebook charger in case it is needed during the test.
