Next week we continue state testing (M-STEP) with grades 3-8 and 11. Parents/guardians are asked to be aware and help your children with preparation to include the shared expectation of being a responsible student during test administration and making a good faith effort.

These tests can seem to be rather lengthy, tiresome and frankly trivial/meaningless to some. The truth is, whether we like it or not, they are a reflection of student *performance* (level of mastery on grade level content and skills) and *growth* (from one year to the next year as compared to similar students) on many levels: individual student, classroom/grade level, and as a school. These tests are also the primary metrics used to rate and compare schools. They are important, and as teachers, staff and parents, we are called to do our part to encourage all BCCS students to put forth their best effort. Your understanding and support is appreciated.

Finally, I extend our sincere appreciation to the 8th-11th grade students who gave their best effort on the PSAT and SAT testing, and the parents for their help with preparation and having every student here on time with their chromebooks fully charged this past week...Thank You!
